

## Sandbox Competition Webinar (12/04/2024) Questions:

- 1. Are all 6 bullets under the Technical Memorandum scoring going to be weighted equally (e.g. each accounting for 10%)?
  - Response: Yes. Each of the subcategories will be weighted equally and submissions will be ranked individually on achieving those criteria.
- 2. Is there a limit to the number of students in one team?
  - Response: No. However, only two (2) students can be part of the presentation team, and one (1) student must be an ITE member.
- 3. Will we get our score card at the end?
  - Response: Yes. Individual Team scoring can be made available on request to teams, we will not be publishing all scores anywhere. Additional scoring information has not been made available in the past.
- 4. Do we have to choose our own campus? I was wondering if ever the team could choose a campus with a bigger/smaller scale.
  - Response: Any requests to perform the work on a campus separate from the submitting school should be requested and detailed. While we understand not all campuses may be ideal, we would encourage using the campus, even if the study area is broadened beyond the campus. If submitting a request to change campuses for the study please include the proposed campus.
- 5. Can you please explain the transferability to another site again? What should we focus on the 2nd site?
  - Professional Response: Professional teams will be provided with a second site and the transferability should be demonstrated in the approach and methodology. The outcomes and design do not need to be detailed for the 2<sup>nd</sup> site.

- Student Response: Student teams should demonstrate the transferability in approach to any other campus or university. Transferability should be demonstrated in the approach and methodology. Do not present outcomes or design for a 2<sup>nd</sup> campus site.
- 6. Can professional teams be composed of members from different employers and not be affiliated with a single company
  - Response: Yes, pending both firms agree to the teaming and do not complete two submissions to the competition. It should also be noted how firms wish to be recognized during the competition.
