NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT

ITE- A Community of Transportation Professionals ITS Standards

NTCIP Foundational Standards (1201, 2202 and 2301)

The final draft versions of the National Transportation Communications for ITS Protocol (NTCIP) Foundational Standards, i.e., NTCIP 1201- Global Object Definitions, NTCIP 2202- Internet Transport Profile and NTCIP 2301-Simple Transportation Management Framework (STMF) Application Profile's proposed Recommended Standards (pRS) were approved as Recommended Standards (RS) by the NTCIP Joint Committee (JC) made up of representatives of American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO), ITE- A Community of Transportation Professionals, and the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) on November 08, 2024. ITE intends to adopt these standards under the Infrastructure Standard Security Implementation (ISSI) project assuming no final appeals are received. Please check the ITE website https://www.ite.org/technical-resources/standards/infrastructure-standard-security-implementation-issi/ for a notice as to whether these versions have been adopted by ITE. When adopted, these standards will be jointly published by ITE, NEMA and AASHTO.

Effective Date of the NOI for these Standards

The deadline to appeal the adoption of these standards as ITE standards is: February 11, 2025, close of business.

How to View the Draft Standards

In addition to the above the ITE web site contains supporting documents and files which are self-explanatory. If no appeals are filed, the ITE International Board of Direction (IBOD), AASHTO and NEMA will ballot these standards and these will be available for a no-cost free download for a period of at least one year. The 508 Compliant versions will also be available.

How to File an Appeal

If you wish to appeal the adoption of the *NTCIP Foundational Standards (NTCIP 1201, 2202 and 2301),* submit a written appeal by the close of business on **February 11, 2025,** to:

The written appeal shall state the nature of the objection(s) including any adverse effects, the step(s) of the ITE procedures or the section(s) of the standard that are at issue, and the specific remedial action(s) that would satisfy the appellant's concerns. Any previous efforts to resolve the objection(s) and the outcome of each shall also be noted.

If an Appeal is Received by ITE

ITE Headquarters will work with the ISSI Base Standards Profile 2 (BSP2) Working Group (WG) to develop a response. Within 30 days after receipt of the appeal, ITE Headquarters shall respond in writing to the appellant, specifically addressing each allegation of fact in the appeal to the extent possible.

If an appeal is not able to be resolved informally in a manner consistent with the ITE procedures, ITE Headquarters shall initiate the process for the appointment of an *Appeals Panel* and will schedule a hearing. If the timeframe for the above actions extends beyond **February 11, 2025**, another notice shall be provided announcing a delay in the anticipated date of adoption by ITE.
