In his role as CTO, Matt will support the Council Leadership Team, six technical councils and 15 standing committees; lead ITE's multi-million-dollar annual contract program; facilitate partnerships with other associations; guide the technical program for the ITE Annual

Meeting and Exhibition and the Spring Conference; and manage the ITE technical staff.

Dr. Hardy most recently was a senior manager with Spy Pond Partners, a dynamic management consulting firm serving transportation and infrastructure management organizations. Prior to that he had a 13-year career at the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) serving as the Senior Program Director for Planning and Performance Management. In this capacity, Matt managed AASHTO's policy and technical activities related to transportation planning, performance management (including asset management, organizational management, and risk management), planning research, and data management in collaboration with state transportation agency representatives and association leadership.

"Matt is well respected in the transportation community, brings extensive knowledge in transportation policy, and has a practical understanding of both engineering and planning principles in our field," said ITE Executive Director and CEO Steve Kuciemba (F). "He also brings a strong educational background in teaching and is excited to work with future leaders and young professionals across ITE's vast membership."
